PLEASE NOTE: The time before the race is hectic, and we have only so many volunteers to help. If you wait until race day to pick up your packet, contents are not guaranteed. Arrive early enough before the race to check your bag and to attach your chipped bib. Picking up your packet during scheduled packet pick-up times in advance is ALWAYS preferable, both for you and for everyone on race morning.

The Yuri's Fun Run Houston is part of an annual worldwide celebration that commemorates the first human in space, Yuri Gagarin, as well as the first orbital flight of the US Space Shuttle. Both of these pioneering events took place on April 12th in 1961 and 1981 respectively.




Race Parking Location

Parking Information

The parking lot is located on the corner of Upper Bay Road and Space Park Dr., across the streeet from Gloria Dei Lutheran Church on Upper Bay Road. Please allow yourself ample time to find a parking space and get to the race start area. Roads on the race course will be CLOSED by 6:45 a.m. Follow the posted signs. Parking is limited. Car pool if you can.

An official race photographer will be on the course and at the finish.









Course Markers

Run through the scenic neighborhood of Nassau Bay, TX. Nassau Bay was established to accommodate NASA Johnson Space Center and provide a community for astronauts, space professionals, and their families. The city is located directly adjacent to Johnson Space Center. Look for signs pointing out where Astronauts have lived.

Visible markers will be positioned along the course. Walkers, strollers and pets (on leash) are welcome!







Timing Chip

Your timing chip is already attached to the back of your race bib. Please use the pins provided in your packet to secure your bib to the FRONT of your shirt.


Do not bend or fold your bib.

The timing chip is disposable and does not need to be removed or returned to us after the race.

NO BIB, NO TIME!

All participants must wear their bib on the front in a way that it can be seen by course officials in order to receive an official finish time when crossing the finish line. If you lose or forget your bib on race day there is a \$10 replacement fee.





- · Running with a bib not registered in your name will result in a two year suspension.
- · All participants must wear their bib on the front in a way that it can be seen by course officials. Non-registered runners and/or bandit runners will be removed from the course. No one will be allowed to finish the race without a bib.
- · Do not fold your bib, it will affect results and timing.
- Transfers are available for \$10 at packet pickup and race day.



Switching Races For Individual (5K to 10K and vice versa):

- · An Individual can switch races with no fees up to the bib name deadline unless the race is full. After the bib name deadline, there is a \$10 charge to switch races and loss of personalized bib.
- · You must Contact us to switch.

The Race Course



Water Stops

Water stops will be located at the start/finish and half-way point of 5K (approximately at 1.5 mile). For 10K, it will be at the start/finish and split-off point of 5K/10K, which you will pass twice (approximately at 1.5 mile and 4.6 mile). For 10K, the longest distance between water stops will be about 3.1 mile. Medical aid station will be located at the start/finish area. Gatorade (Lemon-Lime Flavor) and water will be provided at each water stop.

Photography

Official race photographer, RaceShots.net, will be on the course and at the finish. Smiling faces will likely end up on our Facebook page or on our marketing materials.

Race Etiquette

Races must start and end on time. No runners will be allowed to start a race more than 10 minutes past official start time.

Line up at the starting line according to how fast you plan to run or walk the event. Slower runners and walkers should move to the back of the race pack. Participants with strollers or pets should also move to the back of the race pack. Run or walk no more than two abreast.

Finish Line

Keep moving after you cross the finish line. Results will be posted on-site and also on the official race website at https://www.yurisrunhouston.com/. Finisher's medal will be awarded just outside the finish line.

Safety

Runners and walkers will be expected to follow directions and instructions of race officials. EMT personnel may be riding the course on bicycles. Please let them or any aid station personnel know if you are having any problems. Headphones are allowed. However, volume should be low enough so that you can hear the race officials' instructions.

Race Start Times: We always plan to start on time. In the case of weather or other unexpected events start time may be delayed, but runners will not be allowed to begin their run any later than 10 minutes past when the race is officially started on site.

Timing: Your chip will be on your bib, which you will get with your packet. The timing tag is attached to the back of your bib. All participants must wear their bib on the front in a way that it can be seen by course officials. Do not forget your bib on

race morning. NO BIB, NO TIME. If you forget your bib, you will need to pay \$10 to replace it. Non-registered runners and/or bandit runners will be removed from the course. No one will be allowed to finish the race without a bib.

I can no longer make it to the race. Can I get a refund? If you are unable to make it to the race after signing up, your registration fee is considered a donation to the Houston Expedition Center, and a refund will not be offered. We appreciate your understanding on this matter, and you are, of course, still welcome to pick up your race shirt!

What is the minimum age requirement and do you need a parents or quardian's consent to participate?

The minimum age for the 5K and 10K is 6 years, and we do need the signature of a consenting parent or guardian.

Is there an age limit on the Kids 1K? To participate, there is no age limit for the Kids 1K. In order to be eligible for a prize, kids must be 8 and under.

Are strollers welcome? Yes. We strive to make this event as family friendly as possible. Please be courteous to other runners by moving toward the back of the group at the starting line though.

Are dogs welcome? We realize dogs are very much a part of many people's families, and they are welcome in this race. Please be courteous to other runners by ensuring your dog is on a leash,


